In 1994, the Arizona Game & Fish Department Director approached the Department's Commission to ask for support to enter into a cooperative agreement with the Arizona Chapter of The Wildlife Society for a native plant garden that would serve as a living memorial to those who gave their lives for the betterment of Arizona's wildlife.

In 1995, the Commission granted the Department authority to cooperatively develop the garden on the east side of the then-new Game & Fish License Building.
