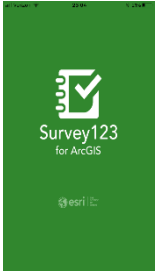


Survey123 – Data Collection

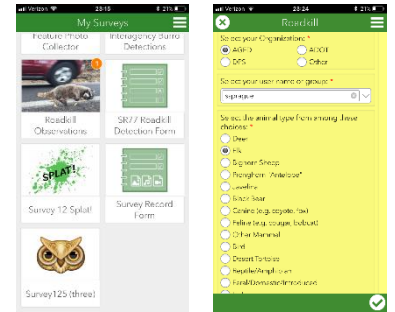

This Survey123 workshop session will guide attendees through the process of shifting from analog (paper and pencil) data collection approaches to a versatile platform for digital data collection that reduce potential for user error and ensures standardization of spatial components. Attendees are encouraged to bring along at least one paper data form to convert into a digital format in a hands on exercise. Instructors will demonstrate how Survey123 can be incorporated with other esri products for a comprehensive user interface.

Intended for students from the morning session or others with previous Survey123 experience, during this afternoon work-session, the instructors from the Survey123 workshop will be available to assist participants in the development and refinement of data collection tools. They will work with attendees to streamline user interfaces, incorporate measures to ensure complete data within feasible value ranges, and develop polished tool presentations. A brief demonstration of harvesting and manipulating data collected using these Survey123 tools will also be included.

Survey123 (and other esri applications) are free to add to your laptop and mobile devices, but they require access to an organization's ArcGIS Online account for full utility. Prior to the class, attendees are strongly encouraged to coordinate with their organizations' GIS program in order to secure credentials for an ArcGIS Online organization "named user" account (so you can retain the tools you develop in the workshop).
